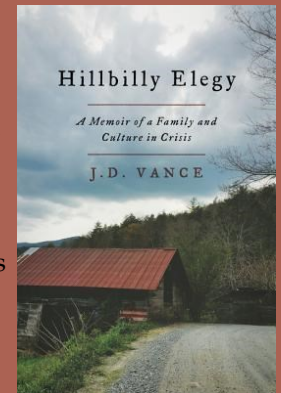

OCPL Welcomes Local Author/Illustrator Timmi Jernigan

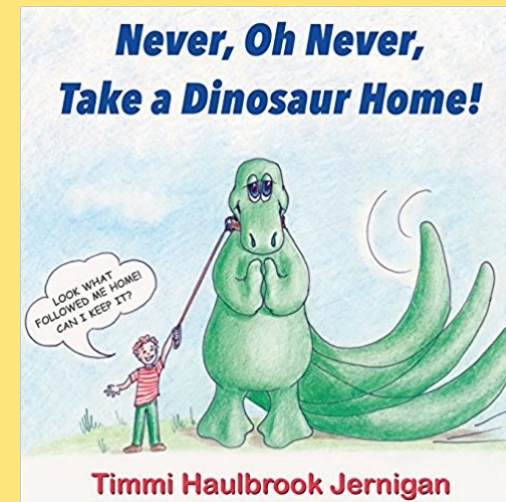
