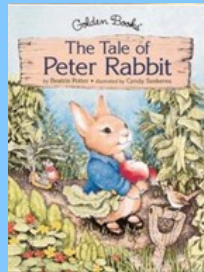
### Peter Rabbit Party

### Time to Read Book Club

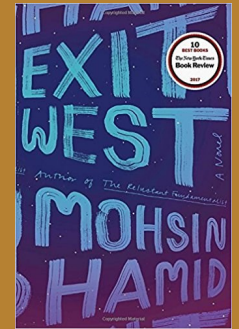

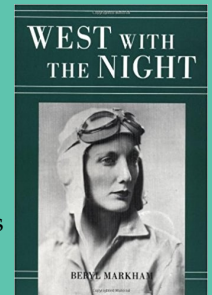
### Let's Talk About It:

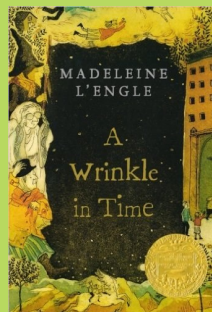
### Forever Young Book Club

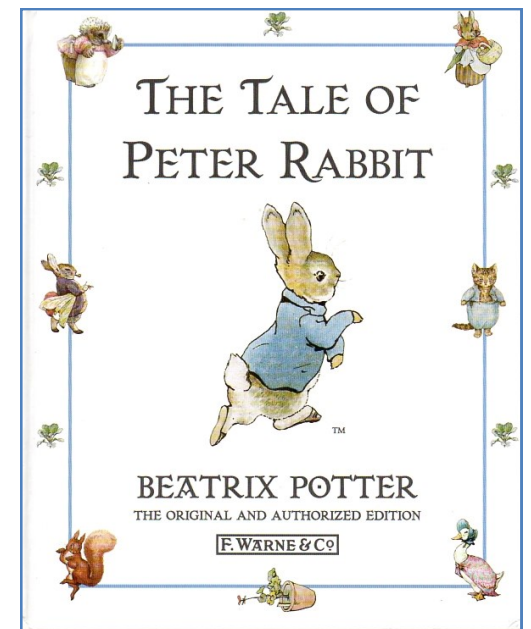

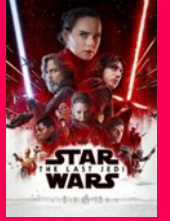

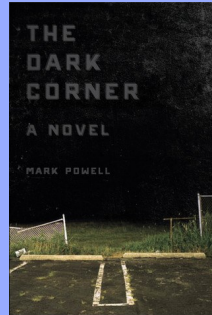
Coloring isn't just for kids anymore. Practice this alternative to meditation on us! Drop in any time during the week and pick up your coloring pages, designed just for adults.
